The BVTeach Program is a grow your own (GYO) program that uses an 8-point high school academy model to provide guidance, resources, and support for high schoolers who wish to become teaching and training professionals. Our academy is a collaborative effort among high schools in the Brazos Valley, Blinn College, and Texas A&M University. BVTeach high school students take advantage of dual credit, teaching and training courses in their high schools and participate in a paid externship. Students who choose to continue their education may apply to become a BVTeach Fellow. Fellows attend Blinn College for up to two years and earn an associate's degree in child development or education with the support of BVTeach staff. These fellows then have the opportunity to apply to a university or college of their choice and, if accepted, pursue a four-year degree in child development or education. So why participate in the BVTeach Program? Students who take dual credit classes (including teaching and training classes) may be able to shave a full year off their college tuition costs. The teaching and training professionals of tomorrow are sitting in our high school classrooms today.
